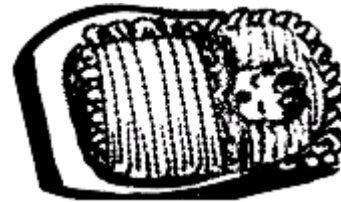




Afghan for Infant Seat in Basic Stitch

9 oz. each, LC and Variegated (VC) Worsted 4 ply yarns.
Baby may be wrapped in it without the infant seat.
Place baby's head over top piece. Fold bottom piece
over baby and overlap side pieces.



STEPS

1. Make a ch of 38 sts with LC. Work for 19 rows alternating LC and VC to form a square. Stop at end of VC PU row.

SHAPING Fig. 1

2. **TH**, cut LC yarn where it ended and tie to edge. Place a LC slip knot on hook and make a ch of 38 sts, continue to CHO sts over PU row, at end of row add a ch of 38 sts. 3. PU sts over the ch, the bars and the last ch, total 114 sts. 4. **TH**, cut VC yarn where it ended leaving end 3" long, tie to edge. Make a slip knot and CHO sts. Continue in pattern for 19 rows. Stop at end of LC CHO row.

SHAPING Fig. 2

5. Bind off with LC, 38 sts. PU 40 sts in center, pull the 40th st through the 39th st to start binding off the last 38 sts, ch 1 to bind off last bar, cut yarn end 3" long and pull it through last loop on hook. Cut VC and tie to edge. 6. **REMEMBER to TH**, for pattern color to match, place a VC slip knot on hook and CHO 38 sts, continue work to match first square size. Stop at end of LC CHO row, bind off with LC on last PU row. Cut VC only and tie to edge. **Do not cut LC.**

FIRST SC EDGE Fig. 3

Use LC to do sc going under 2 strands of yarn at each side row, do 2 sc in each outside corner, but dec at inside corners, start 1 sc at each side, YO and pull them through tog. Finish with any edging.
Hide yarn ends by weaving them through, back and forth, in the same color work. Cut left overs off.
